



Seminary Admission Requirements

1. Completed Application Packet
 - a. Application Interview
 - b. Transcripts from previous high schools, colleges or universities
 - c. Employment Record
 - d. Letters of Reference
 - e. Certificates of Baptism and Confirmation
 - f. Medical Examination Report
 - g. Autobiography
 - h. Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Search
 - i. Psychological Evaluation
 - j. Freedom from Canonical Impediments
2. Panel Interview with Vocations Admission Committee (Three members of the laity.)
3. Approval of Candidate by Vocations Advisory Committee
4. Approval of Candidate by the Archbishop of Vancouver, at which point the candidate receives a personal letter from the bishop confirming his admission.
5. Review and sign Policy of Financial Assistance for Seminarians and Those Ordained to the Transitional Diaconate
6. Review and Sign Seminarian Code of Conduct

Following admittance to the seminary, seminarians will be evaluated each year by the seminary faculty as well as by their peers.

Based upon the information received from the above-mentioned evaluations, the Vocations Advisory Committee, of which the Archbishop is the chair, will decide on a yearly basis whether or not a seminarian will be permitted to continue his formation to the priesthood in the Archdiocese of Vancouver.
