What a journey it has been! In 2016, Archbishop J. Michael Miller set the wheels in motion when he created the Filipino Ministry Office. Deacon Greg Barcelon was assigned this task soon after he was ordained among the pioneer cohort of Permanent Deacons in the Archdiocese of Vancouver. Deacon Greg shared that he expressed his commitment to serve in whatever capacity but did

not imagine the colossal challenge that was put on his shoulder.

In a meeting with the Filipino Catholic Associations in 2017, Archbishop Miller laid down the challenge as follows: "The Filipinos, being in fact the strongest and most numerous - you have a particular responsibility for the overall spiritual and missionary welfare of the whole church of

Vancouver."

Deacon Greg laid down the actions that enabled us to carry out the key Filipino Ministry mandate, i.e., Helping pastors in their work with Filipino parishioners, Creating a Council of Filipino Catholic Associations, Establishing a leadership program for Filipinos, and Hosting periodic large public events.

The foundation was set with teams of volunteers who did an amazing job in leading and supporting the various initiatives, by working together in the spirit of "Bayanihan."
