## Archdiocese administrator to head school board

### *Dan Moric to take over from Doug Lauson following 2015 retirement*

VANCOUVER, July 15, 2014 – Dan Moric, head of administration for the Archdiocese of Vancouver, will become the new Superintendent of the Catholic Schools of the Vancouver Archdiocese (CISVA). The appointment is effective following the retirement of current Superintendent Doug Lauson at the end of the next school year.

Mr. Moric will remain as the Archbishop's Delegate for Administration until moving over to the CISVA on April 1, 2015, for a period of familiarization and planning before assuming full responsibilities July 1.

Archbishop Miller said, "I am very pleased that Dan will be taking over from the capable direction of Doug Lauson. He has had experience working at all levels of Catholic education: in primary and secondary schools, and as Associate Superintendent. He has served the Archdiocese with grace and competence as the Delegate for Administration at the John Paul II Pastoral Centre, overseeing 13 different offices. I look forward to working with him as the new Superintendent responsible for fostering the quality Catholic education that parents expect and our students deserve."

Mr. Moric is a respected educator with a Bachelor of Education degree from Simon Fraser University and a Master's of Religious Education degree from St. Mark's College. His previous positions include:

- 2007-2011 Associate Superintendent of CISVA
- 1999-2007 Principal, St. Thomas Aquinas Regional Secondary
- 1995-1999 Vice-Principal, St. John Brebeuf Regional Secondary
- 1992-1995 Teacher and Department Head, St. John Brebeuf Regional Secondary
- 1987-1992 Teacher, Corpus Christi Elementary (1989 Sabbatical, lived in community with Les Servites de Marie, Bunyuka, Zaire.)

With his wife, Aileen, and his four children, Mr. Moric is an active member of Christ the Redeemer Parish in West Vancouver.

Mr. Lauson will maintain a connection with the CISVA as a part-time consultant for the RCAF Benefits Office.
