### EIGHTEEN COUPLES EMBRACE MATRIMONIAL JOURNEY IN MASS WEDDING 2023

On June 24th, a significant event took place as eighteen civilly married couples came together to celebrate their Mass Weddings. The ceremony was officiated by Archbishop J. Michael Miller, CSB, marking the beginning of their shared matrimonial journey. During the ceremony, Archbishop Miller delivered an inspiring homily that drew parallels between Jesus's first miracle at the wedding in Cana and the sacrament of marriage. He highlighted how, just as Christ revealed His presence and power at that event, He continues to manifest Himself through the sacred union of marriage. The Archbishop emphasized that a marriage, blessed by God, becomes a living testament to His grace and love. He stressed that as couples embrace the call to love and sacrifice for one another, they exemplify selflessness in all circumstances, demonstrating their commitment even through challenges. In his address to the couples, Archbishop Miller reminded them of God's promise to be a constant presence throughout their marriage journey. This steadfast support offers solace and strength during times of joy, as well as trials. The couples were encouraged to walk in faith, understanding that God walks alongside them every step of the way. Drawing an analogy between marriage and a school, the Archbishop emphasized how it serves as a platform for learning love and sacrifice. Each day presents a chance to develop and deepen these virtues, leading to a better understanding of oneself and one's partner. The journey of marriage becomes an avenue to refine qualities such as selflessness, forgiveness, and unwavering commitment. Furthermore, the Archbishop urged the newlywed couples to glean insight from the Mass readings, particularly highlighting the significance of prayer both as couples and as a family. By cultivating a shared spiritual life, they would reinforce their connection and strengthen their relationship with God. Prayer would serve as a wellspring of guidance, comfort, and strength, forming the cornerstone of their marriage and family life.

As this momentous event was celebrated, the profound importance of the Sacrament of Marriage was deeply understood—a divine commitment that sanctifies and teaches couples on their journey to heaven. It is hoped that the couples, bound by this sacrament, will uphold their commitments and find enduring happiness together.
