With the recent revelations of sexual abuse as well as cover-ups at some of the highest levels in the Church, it is important to understand how certain Churchmen have failed, how the Church has responded properly, and what still needs to be done to bring perpetrators to justice and to provide support to victims.

With this information and using the Catholic Voices method, we will be able to answer the question, "Why has it taken so long for the Church to take clerical sexual abuse seriously?" in a way that sheds light and avoids generating heat in discussions with family, friends and professional associates.
