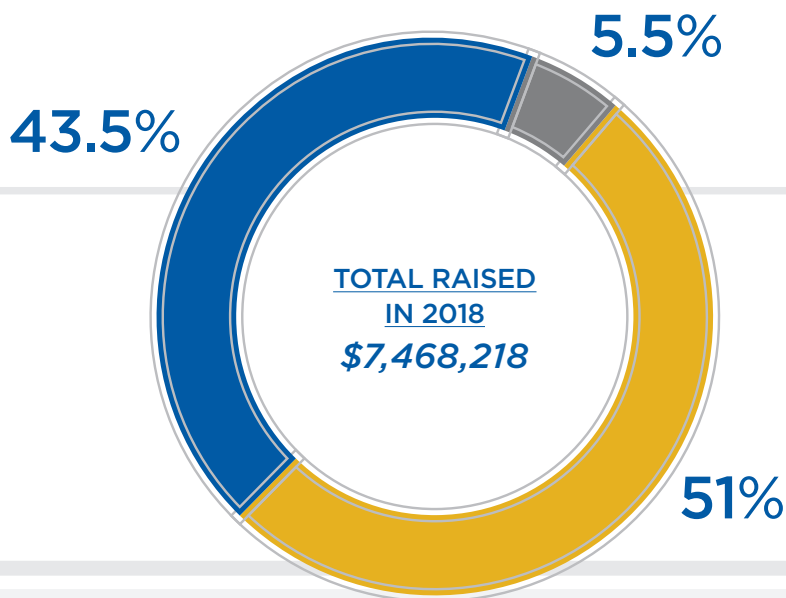
## OUR ANNUAL APPEAL 2018 RESULTS
